A Programme on the jayanthi of savitri Bai Phule was conducted on 3 rd January, 2014. The staff and students took part in it. The principal, Dr.L.Anjali Devi remarked that savitri Bai Phule was born on 3rd January, 1831 in Naiga on and died on 10 th March 1897 in Pune, Maharashtra.

Savitri Bai Phule was one of the first female teachers in India, a Social reformer and poet. she tried to abolish discrimination and unfair treatment of people based on caste and gender. She and her husband were pioneers of women Education in india. Try starlight their first school for girls in 1848 in Pune.

Vice-principal Dr.S.Gulab Jan expressed that she was a pioneer of women's Education in pre - independent India. The First women teacher and headmistress in Indian history. savitri bai Phule is known as the mother of Indian women Education.

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World Hindi Day

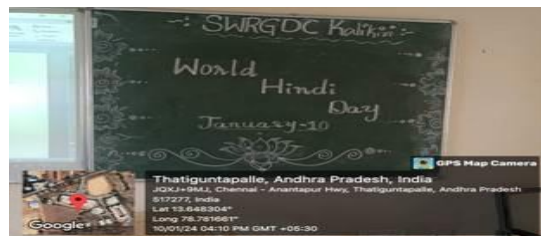
'World Hindi Day' Programme was conducted on 10th January, 2014. The staff and students took part in it.

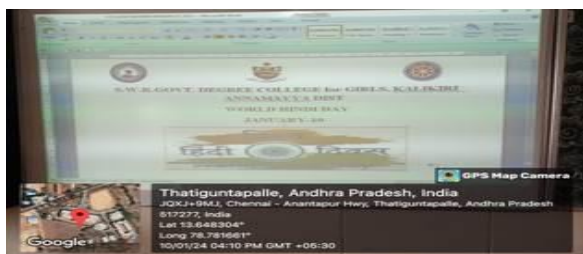

“In order to deal with this problems , the election commission has decided to take up a vigorous exercise to identify all eligible voters attaining the age of 18 years as of January 1st every year in each of the 8.5 lakh polling stations across the country “, she said.
