4. Discussed to maintain records as per NAAC Performa. the decision has been taken to maintain the same





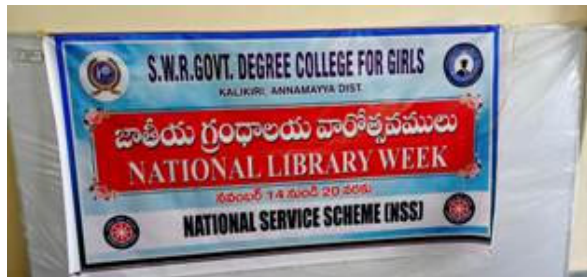
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National Library Week

Phule' also fought for women's rights .Believing that education was essential to bringing about social change he established schools for girls and children of lower castes he was famous for several things among one is ' Do not ask the caste who were involved in your struggle '.
