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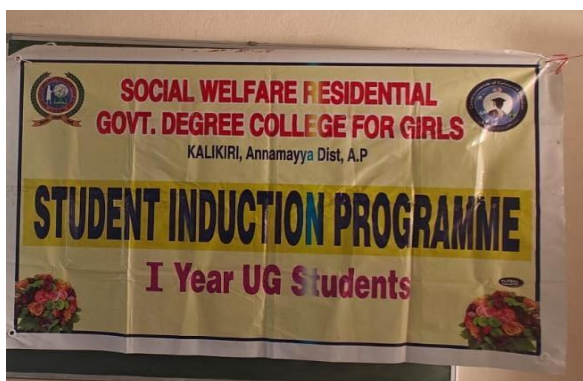


INDUCTION PROGRAMME

The theme for International literacy Day 2024 is “promoting multi lingual education Literacy for mutual understanding and peace.”



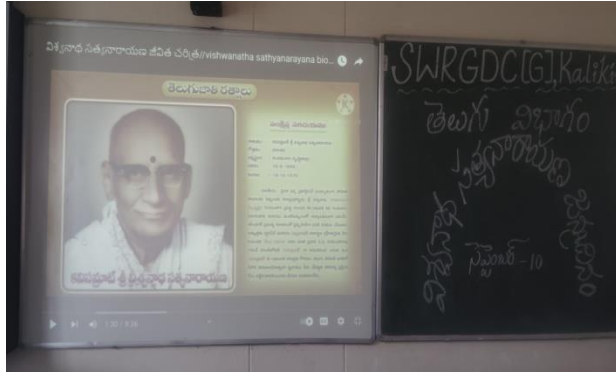

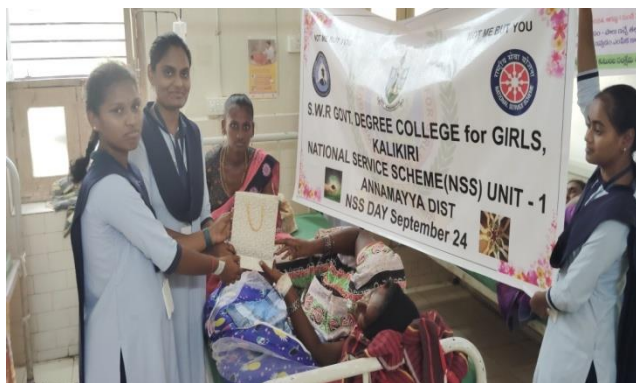


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NSS DAY (NSS DAY ACROSS THE COUNTRY)

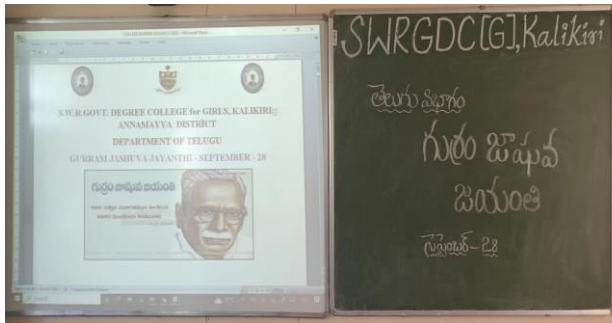
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GURRAM JASHUVA JAYANTHI

He was called the “poet of the millennium” for his timeless pieces of poetry and literature. In 1995, Dalit communities in Andra Pradesh began to organize various centennial celebrations for Jashuva’s birth, and have recently began efforts to revive the remember of his literary contributes.

His literacy works Gabbilam(1941) is Jashuva’s best known work, fashioned after kalidas; Meghaduta(The cloud messenger), in which an exiled lover attempts to communicate his affections to his beloved wife.
